 make and ordaine her my sole Heiress and Executor giving and
 absolutely granting her all pay or arrears of pay due to me in his
 becomen I beare all my worldly goods Wills Bonds due debts or
 demands and I do here by utterly revoke and annulle all former
 Testaments Wills and legacies becomen and Executors before this time
 made confirming this and none other to be my last will and Testament
 In witness hereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the day
 and year above written at Rotterdam in Holland. / Hugh Wauliffe
 his mark. / Signed sealed published pronounced and declared
 by the said Hugh Wauliffe as his last will and Testament in presence
 of / Francis Huysh Chaplain John Heridge Chyrurgeon Edw Booth
 Adjut.

 die when it shall please God to call downe I have opportunity
 where and declare this my last will and Testament in manner following
 (revoking and annulling by these presents all and every former will and
 Wills whatsoever by me made) and first being penitent for my sinne
 most humbly desiring forgiveness for the same I comittid my
 soule to God that gave it hoping and assuredly believing by his great
 mercy and the all sufficient intercession of my blessed Saviour
 Jesus Christ my sins shall be remitted and forgiven and that my
 soule and body being at his generall resurrection again united shall
 inherit the Kingdom of Heaven and I shall happen to dye in
 Plymouth where I now am my desire is that my body may be interred
 in the night in the parish Church of St Andrew abiding all pomp and
 grandeur only accompanied with a very few of my friends to see.
